



Introduction

Sierra Leone is preparing for another political transition with the scheduled 2018 general elections. Amidst post-Ebola recovery challenges, following a series of consultations with his cabinet and the Election Management Bodies (EMBs), in compliance with the necessary constitutional provisions, President Dr. Ernest Bai Koroma, announced that the general elections are to be scheduled March 7, 2018. During this announcement, the President secured the nation and the international community of his Government's preparedness for conducting peaceful elections and a successful political transition. He reaffirmed his commitment to two terms in office as stipulated in Section 46(1) of the 1991 Constitution of Sierra Leone.
