Prof. Isaac Olawale Albert, the pioneer Director of the Institute for Peace and Strategic Studies (IPSS), University of Ibadan, Nigeria and immediate past Chair of the Regional Board of the West Africa Network for Peacebuilding (WANEP), has been recognized for his commitment to consolidating peace and conflict studies in West Africa.
